## 2. Home Screen

Click icon, will return to previous screen.


### 3. Scroll Down Menu



# 1. Phone

- Tap Phone on Captur multimedia system Home Screen.
- Tap 'New Devices' to search for your device and select the correct device name.
- On your mobile phone enter the pin code 0000 to pair to Captur multimedia system.

### ■ Dial or Answer a Call


Using Bluetooth function to dial, receive and reject calls.

1.Enter the number on the keypad, and then tap dial.




### **Dial a Call from Contacts**

Tap dial icon to answer an incoming call.









To add new contacts Sync Address Book again by tapping con.




### ■ History

- •To connect a new device, search the device name as shown below from your mobile phone and select the name. Pin:0000




- To reconnect a device, select the device and tap

### ■ Settings

- Auto Answer: Incoming call will be answer automatically if turn on.
- Auto Connect: Previously paired mobile phones will be connected automatically if turned ON.
- •Contacts Display Order: Tap to change the display interface, first name, last name or last name, first name. After change, please download the phonebook again.



# 2. Radio

- Listen to the radio
- -Tap the Radio icon on the home screen to listen to the Radio.





### ■ Icon function

Tap once: decrease 0.1 MHz
Touch & hold: scan previous station

Tap once: increase 0.1 MHz
Touch & hold: scan next station

Tap it to Search All available radio stations.

Tune to desired radio frequency; tap this icon to save in the list.

Note: To remove/delete from list, press this button again.

Tap it to view scan result. User can select or save all the stations.

Tap to select radio station region and RDS function on/off.

Tap this icon to enable or disable AF (Alternative Frequency) features.

# 3. Music



Listen to your favorite music in the music player.

The system will scan all the music files in iNand and SD/USB device and automatically add them to the playlist.



### ■ Play music

1. Tap Music application to enter the music interface.

2. Tap iNand, SD, USB, Linkpod or BT Music.

3.Tap \_\_\_ to select song / Press play


### Music Management - Create Playlist

# 4. AUX

- 1. In the application list, tap AUX.

# 5. Gallery

Tap Network in the setting interface to select Wi-Fi or portable hotspot features.






### Wi-Fi function

- 2. Press button on the top right side to turn on/off the Wi-Fi function.




- 3. When Wi-Fi is turned on, your device will automatically scan for available networks and display them.

View/Modify day/night brightness, date/time, language and assistive touch.






### Light

Caution: reset to factory mode will erase all the system data and account.



## 23. Phone-Link



Phone-Link achieves the effective connection between Smart Phone and Captur Multimedia System.

### 1. Connect Android Phone through USB Cable:

Please ensure that "USB Debugging" mode is enabled in your mobile Phone.

### Note:

If "USB Debugging" mode is not enabled in your Mobile Phone, then please follow the below steps to enable it:

- →Go to your Mobile Setting and tap "About Device" by continuously pressing "Build Number" to enable "Developer Options".
- $\rightarrow$ Now go back to settings menu and tap "Developer Options" to enable the "USB Debugging".

Connect your Android Phone with Captur multimedia system through USB cable and you will see the below option on your Android Phone screen. Tap "Always allow from this computer" and press OK.



Open the "Phone-Link" application in Captur Multimedia System and tap "Android USB" to connect the Android Phone. (As shown in picture)



Now your phone is connecting..... (As shown in picture)





When the Android Phone is connected with Captur Multimedia System, "Drive Mode" application will be installed automatically in your Android phone.

Drive mode application will run on your Android Phone and Captur Multimedia System automatically. (As shown in picture)



To exit from "Drive Mode" press back key from your Android Phone. Your Android Phone screen now will be mirrored on Captur Multimedia System.

Note: To enable "Drive Mode" option tap "Drive Mode" application through your Android phone.



### 2. Connect Android Phone through Wi-Fi:

If you want to connect your Android Phone through Wi-Fi, then you should follow Step 1 "Connect Android Phone through USB Cable" (Only one-time requirement).

Make sure that your Android Phone and Captur Multimedia System is connected on same Wi-Fi network. Open "Phone-Link" application in Captur Multimedia System and tap "Android Wi-Fi". (As shown in picture)



Now your Android Phone is connecting.....(As shown in picture)





When your Android Phone connects with Captur Multimedia System you will see "Drive Mode" application screen on Android Phone and Captur Multimedia System.



To exit from "Drive Mode" press back key from Android Phone. Your Android Phone screen now will be mirrored on Captur Multimedia System.

Note: To enable "Drive Mode" option tap "Drive Mode" application through your Android phone.

### 3. Connect iPhone through Wi-Fi

Open your iPhone "HOTSPOT" and connect Captur Multimedia System with it.

Open "Phone-Link" application in Captur Multimedia System and tap "iPhone Wi-Fi". (As shown in picture)





Swipe up on your iPhone screen and tap AirPlay. (As shown in picture)



Tap the device name and turn on Mirroring.

Now your iPhone has been connected and you will get your iPhone screen on Captur Multimedia System.


Please make sure that your Smart Phone Bluetooth is connected with Captur Multimedia System for Audio Playback.



# 24. Voice Assistant



Voice Assistant is a feature that allows the users to control the system by voice commands. The user only needs to activate it and give a command to make the system do the right operation.



### Activate the Voice Assistant

Tap Voice Assistant in the application list to activate the Voice Assistant feature. Then a voice saying "Can I help you" will be heard. You must give a command from the list given or the system will say "Time out" and exit.



### Say a Command

Say a command to make the system do the operation for you. In different modes, you can choose the words listed in the Voice Assistant application. If a command is not included in the given list, the system will not recognize or will cause a wrong operation.

Caution: Working of Voice Command depends on user's accent and environment.

# 25. Navigation



Navigation app for searching locations and navigating to places even when offline. With connectivity, users can search online for more and accurate results and update the map database.






### ■ Search

Using 'Search' function to search for location, roads and etc and then select the desired result.

If not results appear, press 'Search Online' to search for more results. (Note: Internet connectivity is require)




### ■ Search for Renault Showroom or Service Centre

To search for Renault showroom or service centre, press 'More' then the 'Renault' icon.




### ■ Filtering

### ■ To End/Stop Navigation


Navigation will end automatically once user reaches the destination. To stop manually, press the 'X' stop navigation icon at navigation main page.

CCD camera shows no image.	Camera function off.	Camera function off Countermeasures: Go to setting, others, CCD. Turn on the CCD camera function

GPS fails to find the current position	GPS antenna is not connected.	Have a qualified installer check connection.
Blank on the map	Navigation may be set with too large or too small proportional size.	Try to change the zoom ratio to see if it can return to the map display. If it is still notsolved, please restart the map application.
