Check Point 12

- 1. The operating temperature of this product is limited to $-10^{\circ}C \sim + 70^{\circ}C$. Non operating temperature of this product is limited to -10°C ~ + 85°C
- 2. From time to time when your vehicle is extremely hot or cold. You must allow time for your air conditioner or heater to cool or heat the vehicle for operating temperature to return to normal operating ranges. Your monitor will return to its normal functions when these operating ranges are achieved.
- 3. Your optimum picture quality is achieved when you are directly in front of the monitor (+/-30 degrees).
- 4. Do not open covers and repair yourself. Refer servicing to qualified personnel.

Power ON/OFF

- **OSD Time Out** Adjust the duration time of MENU display
- 1. Press the **I**/**button** on the remote control to move to SETUP Mode() after press the MENU button on the remote control.



- 2. Press \blacktriangle/∇ button on the remote control to select the OSD Time Out.
- 3. Press the $\triangleleft/\triangleright$ button on the remote control to select the desired duration time of MENU display.
- 4. After the adjustment, press the MENU button on the remote control to return to the previous screen.

Setup Control

- **Restore Default** Return to the default factory settings.
- 1. Press the **◄/▶ button** on the remote control to move to SETUP Mode() after press the **MENU button** on the remote control.



- 2. Press \blacktriangle/ \forall button on the remote control to select the **Restore Default**.
- 3. Press **button** on the remote control to start the **Restore Default**.
- 4. Select "YES" to confirm it.

Display whether USB device is detected or not.

Select either picture, music, movie or text icon in the main screen by pressing the ◄/► button on the remote control and press the ENTER button.

The system will automatically show

If no device is connected, the icons will not be displayed.

During playback, press **STOP** to stop the playback. if photo file was being displayed, system will be back to the browser mode or file management mode. if movie file was being displayed, system will be back to the file management mode.

During playback, Press "**F.B**" and the playback speed will increase and the system will search backwards. Speed settings: from x2(double the original speed) to x16(16 times the original speed). Under x16, you can go back to normal playing speed by pressing "**F.B**" once again. Press "**PLAY/PAUSE**" under any speed and you will return to normal playing speed.

Under x16, you can go back to normal playing speed by pressing "**F.F**" once again. Press "**PLAY/PAUSE**" under any speed and you will return to normal playing speed.





PREV : Go to the previous file

The starting point for the repeated segment will be the point where you pressed "A-B" for the first time, and the end point for the repeated segment will be the point where you pressed "A-B" for the second time. The OSD will display A-B Repetition and the chosen segment will be played continuously. Press the "A-B" button once again and the system will go back to normal playback.

Precautions for using the USB port

- Some USB device might not be supported. It depends on the the specifications of the device.
- If the USB storage device is connected through a USB hub, the device is not recognizable.
- An USB storage device using an automatic recognition program might not be recognized.
- The recognition speed of a USB storage device may depend on each device.
- Do not unplug the USB device while the music/movie/pictures are playing. Stop the playback first, otherwise the files may be corrupted.
- Connect power to a USB storage device which requires an external power supply. if not, the device might not be recognized.
- Connect an USB storage device with cable is offered by USB maker. If the connected cable is not offered by USB maker or an excessively long cable, the device may not be recognized.
- Please backup important files because data on USB device might be damaged. Data management is consumer's responsibility and as a result, the manufacturer does not cover the data damage.
- Searching time may be longer when files are located in many sub folders.
- This device does not support saving files to the USB Storage.
- Folder or file name is limited to 100 words.
- If the USB storage device requires high voltage more than 800mA or 5V, it might not be recognized.
